Role: Fundraising and Events Organisers

About KVIN:

Kirklees Visual Impairment Network is a user-led organisation run by and for people with Visual Impairments (VIs). We want to be able to enrich visually impaired people's lives through enabling them to use products and technology (equipment, software and apps) that can help them be as independent as possible and enjoy life to the full. We run drop-in peer support sessions in Huddersfield and Dewsbury to support people to know what technology may benefit them and train them to use them.

Role description:

We need organised and proactive people to help KVIN raise money through local activities and events or online fundraising.

You can work on your own or part of a team to develop a fundraising idea, it could be a sponsored walk, run or bike ride, a bake sale or coffee morning or something larger scale such as a concert or meal.

We have a fundraising group who meet to develop ideas and plan. You choose how much you want to be involved, help in all areas is appreciated.

This role is flexible, but we ask you attend the office for induction and periodically to keep up to date.

This role is suitable for volunteers with Visual Impairments.

Days and times: Wednesday, Thursday or Friday 10am to 4pm. Flexible commitment.

You have some experience in fundraising for charities, but support will be given.

You want to give your time to KVIN to benefit local people with visual impairments.

What you will gain:

Become part of a friendly and dedicated team.

Meet new people and make friends.

Gain skills and experience for your career.

Have a great feel good feeling as a result of getting involved.

Be offered training opportunities to develop in your role.

Additional information:

You will need 2 referees before you can start this role.

An induction to the organisation and role will be provided.

Travel expenses will be reimbursed and any other out of pocket expenses incurred.

You will be undertaking your role in spaces where there are Guide Dogs present.

KVIN have a flexible approach to volunteering and a variety of roles available to suit individuals who want to get involved.
